She draws, carves, and prints each linocut by hand, and creates her cyanotype prints with plants from her garden and surrounding environment. Amy began her printmaking journey while earning her bachelor's degrees in graphic design and advertising from Drake University in Des

Moines, IA. At that time her focus became intaglio printmaking (etching), and she went on to win several awards for her intricate and thought-provoking work. Amy returned to relief printmaking in late 2019, and added cyanotype and monotype printmaking to her practice soon afterwards.
