Her most successful achievements came in 2023. At the Minnesota State Fair she was awarded and juried into the Fine Arts building with “Chris Cornell,” glass on glass mosaic. She was awarded with the “Maple Grove Arts Center Award,” and “Minnesota Figure Study Collaborative Award.” In the Creative Activities building she was awarded 4th place for “Tulip” style Tiffany Lamp. Later in the year she received two more awards for her stained glass guitar “The Crow and the Butterfly,” at Frame Works in St. Paul, MN. She was awarded the Second Place People’s Choice Award and Minnesota Artist Association Members Juried Exhibit Fall 2023 Honorable Mention.

This year she is working on new artwork for teaching classes, art shows and some commissions. She will be teaching mosaic classes at Edina Art Center and White Bear Center for the Arts. She is participating in several art shows throughout the year including the St. Paul Art Crawl and Minnesota State Fair. Her biggest goal this year will be creating new artwork for her solo show in 2025 in March at “Paradise Center for the Arts.”
