



District 279 Teachers Show

A Call for Artwork Submission

The Maple Grove Arts Center opens the gallery to all District 279 Teachers to submit their artwork for a teacher's only exhibition in conjunction with the District 279 Students Show (at the MG Government Center.)

Eligibility:

Entries must be original work created solely by the artist in the last 5 years and not previously exhibited at Maple Grove Art Center (MGAC). Both 2D and 3D artwork will be allowed.

Media, Conditions & Exclusions:

Recent paintings, drawings, fibers, batik, hand pulled prints, sculpture and photography

*Photography that is digitally enhanced is allowed if clearly marked as such.

Artwork must be original. Paintings must be dry. Drawings, prints, watercolors, fibers, batik must be under glass. All two-dimensional work must have wire for hanging.

All excepted entries must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show:

March 15 – April 21

Every precaution will be taken in handling artwork, but no responsibility is assumed by MGAC for loss or damage of any kind. Maple Grove Art Center cannot be responsible for loss or damage. Submission of these works indicates acceptance of these conditions. Artists who desire to insure their work must make their own arrangements.

No copies, class-work, food-items, hazardous materials or fragile work can be accepted.

Submission of work:

Registration form and procedures attached. Artwork, entry form, fee and release must be delivered to MGAC at time of submission.

Sales:

Payment is made to the Maple Grove Arts Center. Center requires a 25% member/ 40% non-member commission on all sales resulting from this show. Artists are responsible for all related sales tax.
